



WHAT IS A POKER RUN?

The LWPA Poker Run is an excuse to meet up with friends and neighbors, enjoy the lake and have a good time. **The 2023 event takes place on Saturday, August 19, from 2:00 to 5:00pm with a rain date of Saturday, August 26.**

The LWPA Poker Run has little to do with poker, beyond using the hand rankings to score the game. To play, all you need is a scoresheet and a winning attitude!

On the day of the Poker Run, you can get your scoresheet at any of the 5 dealer pontoon boats marked with red flags -- for a \$20 donation to the LWPA (cash preferred). Once you have your scoresheet, take a leisurely cruise to each of the dealer boats in any order you choose. At each dealer boat, give your scoresheet to the dealer and you will be dealt one card. You can also purchase one extra card at any of the dealer boats during the game for an additional \$10. The dealer will mark your scoresheet and hand it back to you. For your final hand to be counted and scored, please turn in your scoresheet to any dealer boat no later than 5:00pm. LWPA volunteers will tabulate and score all scoresheets, and the winner of the game will be the player who has the best five-card poker hand at the end of the event. Second and third place winners will also be determined by their hands. Winners will be announced at 7:00pm at the Boat Club, or reached by phone, so please be sure that your name and phone number are clearly printed on your scoresheet.

POKER RUN RULES





- There are no prizes for the boat that does not matter who completes the game first. It is not a race.
- The winning hand is determined using standard poker hand rankings. When you draw your last card, give your scoresheet to that dealer boat, by 5:00pm.
- Each dealer boat has its own deck of cards. You will be dealt a card at each boat. If you are dealt a duplicate card, you will be dealt another. Each participant must have an official scoresheet, which MUST be filled in by LWPA volunteers, NOT by Poker Run participants.
- Please follow boat safety rules. Dealer boats will be anchored and their crew will assist you in tying up. There could be a fair amount of boat traffic, so watch for other watercraft as you navigate, and be courteous!
- Players participate at their own risk, agree to use good judgement and follow all safety instructions. All players agree to indemnify and hold harmless any of the dealers, the LWPA, or Wickaboag Boat Club in the event of damages or liabilities that may arise from participating.

Winning Poker Hands in Order

- 1 **Royal Flush** Run of sequential cards from 10 to Ace, all cards the same suit
- 2 **Four of a Kind** Four cards of the same rank plus a pair
- 3 **Full House** Three cards of the same rank plus a pair
- 4 **Flush** Five cards, all cards same suit
- 5 **Straight (run)** Five sequential cards, not of the same suit
- 6 **Three of a Kind** Three cards of the same rank
- 7 **Two Pairs** Two sets of pairs
- 8 **Pair** Two cards of the same rank
- 9 **High Card** If you have none of the above, the highest card in your hand plays
